Requirements for Admission:

For ICCA: Candidate must be a graduate or have passed professional qualification considered to be degree equivalent such as: Intermediate or final examinations of comparable professional bodies or has held, or is holding a working position in Credit Management, and has held such position for at least one to two years or has successfully followed a recognised course of study in a related field, such as Postgraduate Diploma in Financial Management, Accounting, Banking, Marketing or Management.

For: ICCF: Candidates must be a holder of at least BA/B.Sc degree or equivalent professional qualification. We expect prospective students to come from a wide range of industries and backgrounds, bringing a wealth of experience to the programme. Applicants with significant credit work experience will be admitted. Also, mature and academically qualified candidate desiring to shift career to credit management will be considered.

Programme Duration/Learning Method:

Each programme runs for 16 month; Student receives study pack for independent reading, do consistent coursework assignments which are in the study packs. There will also be semester examinations, project research work, and weekend general class occasionally.

Registration Process And Method of Admitting Students:

Payment of non-refundable application fee of £50.00 or its naira equivalent to obtain admission form

Programme fees: International Certified Credit Associate (ICCA) in credit management - £650.00

International Certified Credit Fellow (ICCF) in credit management - £1,200.00

Sixty percent (60%) of the fee must be paid to commence the programme, balance is paid six months there after.

Student have the option of paying in naira using exchange rate of N280 or pay in pounds sterling
